

## Translation

### Article 1°

#### Rights to Access

1— People with disability have the right to be escorted by assistance dogs to access places, transports and public establishments.

2— For this law to be applied you should consider an assistance dog as an educated dog or in training process to escort, lead and help disabled person.

3—The concept of assistance dog includes the following categories:

- a) Guide dogs, educated dog or in training process to help a visually handicapped person;
- b) Hearing dog, educated dog or training process to help a hearing handicapped person;
- c) Service dog, educated dog or training process to help people with mental, organic or motor handicap.

### Article 2°

#### Aim of the law

The assistance dogs when accompanied by the handicapped person or by the accredited instructor can access to places, transports and public establishments as:

- a) Public transports, namely national companies airplanes, boats, trains, buses, electrical cars, metro and taxis;
- b) Public or private schools;
- c) Rehabilitation and professional educational centers;
- d) Any kind of sports centers, namely stadiums, gyms, swimming pools and others;
- e) Show and entertainment venues and game rooms;

- f) Central, regional and local public administration services buildings, including public institutes;
- g) Public and private health establishments;
- h) General public services such as banks, insurance companies, post offices, and other;
- i) Commercial establishments including shopping centers, department stores and supermarkets;
- j) Food and touristic establishments including restaurants, coffee shops, drink shops and others open to public
- l) Accommodation establishments such as hotels, hostels, inns and others;
- m) Elderly care centres
- n) Leisure and touristic places such as beaches, camping parks, gardens, spas and others;
- o) Work places.
